



## FAQ Transcript

Lee: Welcome back to the Gilman Scholarship Program podcast. I'm your host, Lee Rivers, with-

Lee: Today we are going to tackle a few frequently asked questions. The first question deals with the issue how to apply for the Gilman Scholarship. Let's begin by answering this question by focusing on when our listeners can apply for the scholarship.

Christine: That's a good place to start. Students should apply for the scholarship in the academic term prior to the start of their study abroad program. For example, if your program starts between July 15<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup> then you should apply for the Fall cycle, which opens in late February. If your program starts between December 15<sup>th</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup>, then you should apply for the Spring cycle which opens in August. You can find the exact application deadlines on the Gilman website. Be sure to check it out!

Christine: Thanks, Lee. So now that you know when to apply for the scholarship, how do you apply for the scholarship?

Lee: We've worked hard to simplify the application process by creating an online application system. In this system the student creates an online account with username and password. The application system will be available approximately 2 months prior to the application deadline for each cycle.
