



## **AES Summer Intern Program**

### **Company Overview**

As one of the world's largest power companies, AES owns and operates a diverse and growing portfolio of generation and distribution businesses. Two of the largest businesses within AES are Brazil's Eletropaulo (distribution) and Chile's Gener (generation). AES's power plants encompass a broad range of technologies and fuel types, from coal to gas to renewables such as wind, solar, hydro and biomass. With operations in 29 countries on five continents, AES has the capacity to serve 100 million people worldwide. The company has a global workforce of 28,000 people who generate and distribute the electricity that accelerates businesses, energizes hospitals and schools, and elevates the quality of life.

### **Position Summary**

Summer internships are available with The AES Corporation during the summer of 2012. Typical internships require a 10-12 week commitment of 40 hours per week to complete several projects focused in particular business needs. The Intern will be assigned specific projects for which they will have full accountability and set deliverables to be met by the end of the internship. They will also work as team members on various assignments and support other AES activities and groups as requested. Work will vary depending on the corporate group.
