



ASEAN Cooperation Plan Activity Summary

Transnational Crime

Activity: Counter-terrorism and Anti-piracy
Funding: \$11,000
Status

- Workshop on Counter-terrorism and Anti-piracy attended by 55 participants, including representatives of all 10 ASEAN Countries and the ASEAN Secretariat, Manila, April 2004.
- Rewards Program Seminar planned, Bali, mid-2006.
- Seminar on Maritime Domain Awareness and Security planned, Kuala Lumpur, 2006.
- Counter-terrorism Consultant based at the ASEAN Secretariat for three months and national research teams identified in Cambodia and Thailand, February 2006.

Activity: Improved Collection of Data on Human Trafficking Among ASEAN Countries
Funding: \$292,000
Implementors: International Organization for Migration (IOM)
Status

- An IOM-appointed expert has been based at the ASEAN Secretariat since October 2005.
- National research teams have been established in Jakarta and Manila, and are being recruited in Cambodia and Thailand.
- Workshops planned to examine findings and to table an ASEAN-wide project, 2006.

Activity: Trade and Customs Controls for Endangered Species
Funding: \$456,000
Status

- A special meeting of the ASEAN Ministers responsible for implementing the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species and of Wild Flora and Fauna (CITES), Bangkok, December 2005, resulting in an ASEAN Ministers' Statement and the launch of the ASEAN Wildlife Law Enforcement Network (ASEAN-WEN).
- Training is planned in improving cooperation among regional law enforcement agencies and creating CITES analytic models to improve export permitting processes.
