



## ASEAN Cooperation Plan Activity Summary

### Infectious Diseases

**Activity:** HIV/AIDS Control and Prevention  
**Funding:** \$1,700,000  
**Status**

This activity supports the ASEAN Work Programme on HIV and AIDS II through: (1) increasing access to affordable drugs and test reagents; (2) regional policy studies on socioeconomic impact of HIV and AIDS in ASEAN Region; (3) capacity building to design and implement HIV, STI and behavioural surveillance system, and to maximize data use in policy development and program design; (4) capacity building workshops for treatment, care and support; (5) regional training on HIV prevention, treatment, and care services for drug users, and scaling up HIV prevention/treatment among drug users; and (6) Organizational support to ASEAN Secretariat. Activities include:

- Workshop on Socio-Economics Impact of HIV and AIDS in Southeast Asia, Manila, October 2005.
- Regional technical meeting, Jakarta, October 2005, to develop a framework for increasing access to Anti-retrovirals and diagnostic reagents.
- Regional Capacity Building Workshops for treatment, care and support, Bangkok, November 2005.
- Regional Dialogue on HIV prevention, treatment and care services for injecting drug users, Kuala Lumpur, December 2005.
- Workshop on using data and information for effective HIV/AIDS policy and planning, Bangkok, December 2005.
- Second workshop on using data and information for effective HIV/AIDS policy and planning, Laos, February 2006.
- Third workshop on using data and information for effective HIV/AIDS policy and planning (Leadership Forum), Viet Nam, March 2006.
- Second and Third capacity-building workshops for treatment, care and support, scheduled for the first half of 2006.

- Curriculum development on HIV prevention, treatment and care services for injecting drug users, scheduled for the first quarter of 2006.
  - Training course on HIV prevention, treatment and care services for injecting drug users, Malaysia, scheduled for April 2006.
