









OPEN DOORS FACT SHEET: THAILAND

INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION Educational Exchange Data from *Open Doors 2011*

In the 2010/11 academic year, **8,236** students from Thailand were studying in the United States (down 4% from the previous year). Thailand is the fifteenth leading place of origin for students coming to the United States.

Academic Level: The majority of Thailand students study at the graduate level. In 2010/11, their breakdown was as follows:

29.8% undergraduate 52.5% graduate students

8.2% other

9.6% OPT (Optional Practical Training)

Historical trends: After significant decreases 2002/03 and 2003/04, the number of students from Thailand began increasing again in 2005/06 through 2007/08. The number of students from Thailand dropped again, by 3% in 2008/09, 2% in 2009/10 and 4% in 2010/11.
