## **Russell Berrie Fellowship in Interreligious Studies**

### **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS – 2014**

The application and all supporting materials must be submitted in English. All supporting documents in other languages must be accompanied by an (unofficial) English translation.

#### ***Applicants should submit***

1. Completed Fellowship **Application Form**;
2. **Two Essays** (applicants are asked to answer questions about their leadership potential and their interest in interreligious studies);
3. **Official Transcripts** of relevant studies. Students currently studying at the Angelicum should submit an official transcript for the academic year they are currently attending;
4. **Curriculum Vitae**;
5. **Two Letters of Recommendation** from individuals who can attest to the applicant's academic record, leadership potential and interest in interreligious affairs. Applicants are encouraged to find recommenders whose reference assists the forming of a complete picture of them. Recommenders should use the Letter of Reference Form or write a letter on official letterhead with a signature. Both letters must be sent in sealed envelopes and the person writing the recommendation must sign across the sealed area of the flap to ensure confidentiality.
6. **Writing sample.** A maximum 10 pages long piece of, preferably, academic writing (or excerpt) related to interreligious dialogue.

#### ***Guidelines***

- Apply only if you are eligible. Read all the scholarship requirements and directions carefully. Make sure you are eligible before you send in your application. Ineligible applications will not be processed.
- Complete the application form in full. If a question does not apply to you, note that on the application. Do not leave any question blank. Be sure to supply all additional supporting materials, including transcripts, letters of recommendation, and essays.
- Follow directions. Provide everything that is required. However, do not supply materials that are not requested, as they will not be taken into consideration, nor will they be returned to you.
- Neatness counts. Always type your application, or if you must print (handwrite), do so neatly and legibly. Place the requested documents in the package in the order that they are requested. This consistency makes it easier for evaluators to locate information. It is also simpler for you to check the documents against the list of requirements.
- Do not staple documents together; if needed, please use paper clips to keep materials together. Do not place the application in a special folder.
- Keep all deadlines.
- Make sure your application gets where it needs to go. Send the printed package by registered express post, "return receipt requested," or use a delivery service that allows you

to track the package's path and verify who signed for it. In this way you will have proof that the application was received. If you do not receive confirmation within three weeks, please follow up.

- Keep a backup file in case anything goes wrong. Before sending the application, make a copy of the entire packet. This way if your application is lost, you will be able to reproduce it quickly.
- Give it a final 'once-over' before sending it. Proofread the entire application carefully. Be on the lookout for misspelled words or grammatical errors. Ask a friend or teacher to proofread it as well.
- Ask for help if you need it. If you have questions or problems with the application, do not hesitate to email (or call) the program administrators.

### ***Application Deadline***

The application deadline is **March 21, 2014**. The entire application must be **posted by** this date.

### ***Mailing Instructions***

- In order for an application to be considered, applicants must **email a completed application form** and mail a **complete printed application package** by the deadline.
- The completed e-application form must be submitted to [berrie@iie.eu](mailto:berrie@iie.eu). Please include your name and the words "application form" in the subject line. Upon submission of the electronic application form, candidates will receive a confirmation e-mail that the application form was received. This, however, does not constitute a complete application package.
- To finalize the application, candidates must send a printed copy of the application package. **Please submit the original application plus 5 complete (photo)copies to IIE Europe.**

The applications should be compiled in the following order:

- Completed Application Form, signed and dated
- Essays (2)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Official Transcript(s)
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- Writing sample

*Please do not staple documents together; use paper clips to keep individual copies together.*

*IIE will send a confirmation e-mail to the applicant upon receipt of the printed application materials. Please note: if you have not received confirmation from IIE within three weeks of submission that your application is complete, it is your responsibility to follow up with IIE.*

- IIE does not accept additional application documentation by email or fax (e.g., transcripts, letters of recommendation, etc.).
- Applications posted after **March 21, 2014** will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Applicants are advised to keep a complete copy of application materials in case of delivery problems. **No application materials will be returned to applicants.**
