



Leveraging Leadership in Ethiopia Accelerator Program



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EMERGING QUESTION

What would it take to develop and energize leaders who can collaborate across sectors, exercise their own leadership, inspire leadership in others, and develop and implement initiatives that improve critical SRHR outcomes in their communities?

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

LLEAP is a leadership development program designed by IIE—Institute of International Education and supported by Packard Foundation.

LLEAP's current targets are emerging leaders in the Oromia Region who are strategically positioned and work on SRHR/related programs. In a Cohort, 24 mid-level leaders, with a good balance of participants from government, civil society and private sectors including media are participating. The team maintains gender balance and will be dominated by emerging leaders.

RESULTS

The program aims to strengthen leadership skills at different level: personal, organizational, and community level.

Fellows will emerge from LLEAP with a 21st century leadership mindset; enhanced personal leadership, adaptive to ever changing global environment, responsive to current challenges and future demands; and proactively contribute to the improvement of SRHR in the country.



LEARNING PACKAGE

LLEAP is a one-year program and built around three integrated Modules, Program Exposure Visit, Mentoring and Action Learning Initiative.

The Modules

Module I: Personal leadership-entrepreneurial mindset

Module II: Transformational Leadership-skills in times of disruption/change

Module III: System Leadership - Interconnectedness, Collaboration, system thinking

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ◆ Demonstrated interest and experience in SRHR
- ◆ Readiness or interest in leading
- ◆ Demonstrated desire and/or experience bridging differences and work collaboratively with others.
- ◆ First degree in any discipline
- ◆ Willingness and ability to participate fully and a commitment to attend all convening's and activities over the course of a year
- ◆ Demonstration of support from their organization,
- ◆ English Language proficiency
