



JAPAN-IMF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR ADVANCED STUDIES, 2019 - 2021

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Japan-IMF Scholarship Program (JISP) you must be:

- A Japanese citizen
- Pursuing an advanced degree in Economics at a top university outside of Japan; and
- Able to complete your PhD by age 34.

ONLINE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applications must be submitted online at: <https://apply.iie.org/janimf>. Email janimfscholarship@iie.org with any questions or problems. A complete application must be in English and include the following:

- Application form
- A personal statement of no more than 500 words, primarily focusing on the applicant's career goals and interest in working as an IMF economist.
- All post-secondary school transcripts
- 2 letters of recommendation: to be submitted electronically, by 2 different referees.
- Reported GRE and TOEFL test scores. It is not required to upload the GRE or TOEFL scores.
- A scanned digital copy of an application to a doctoral program (if not yet accepted to or attending a program).
