



JAPAN-IMF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR ADVANCED STUDIES

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Japan-IMF Scholarship Program (JISP) you must be:

- A Japanese citizen
- Pursuing an advanced degree in Economics at a top university outside of Japan
- Interested in pursuing a career at either the IMF or in your home administration, and
- Able to complete your PhD by age 34.

ONLINE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applications must be submitted online at: [LINK]. Email japanimfscholarship@iie.org with any questions or problems. A complete application must be in English and include the following:

- Application form
- A personal statement of no more than 500 words, primarily focusing on the applicant's career goals and interest in working as an IMF economist.
- All post-secondary school transcripts
- 2 letters of recommendation: to be submitted electronically, by 2 different referees.
- GRE and TOEFL test scores: Scores should be entered into the online application, IIE does not require you to upload the score report document.
- A minimum of one institution to which you have applied for enrollment in a doctoral program.
