ENU is one of the leaders of Kazakhstan's higher education and science. Since September 2022, ENU has received the status of a research university. The achievements of our university are recognized in the international educational space and noted in world rankings. Thus, according to the results of 2023, the University ranks 355th in the world in the QS ranking and is also among the top 100 best universities in Asia. More than 20 thousand students' study at ENU, including foreign citizens from 25 countries, it trains bachelors, masters and PhDs in more than 260 educational programs, and also implements postdoctoral and MBA/EMBA programs. The university issues a European Diploma Supplement. Teaching is conducted in 3 languages (Kazakh, Russian and English) by leading professors and experts in their fields, including more than 40 programs in English. Along with this, more than 60 double degree programs are being implemented jointly with foreign universities.

The university includes 13 faculties (Faculty of Mechanics and Mathematics, Faculty of Information Technology, University of Architecture and Civil Engineering, Faculty of Natural Sciences, Faculty of Social Sciences, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Philology, Faculty of Economics, Faculty of International Relations, Faculty of Physics and Technology, Faculty of Journalism and political science, history department and transport and energy department).

- b) Students from USA can visit ENU in the framework of academic mobility for one semester without any fees, at the same time ENU provide free accommodation.
- 3. Academic exchange. Lecturing and training for Kazakhstan and U.S. faculties with financial support from the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and ENU
- 4. Developing double diploma programs in for preparation the qualified specialist for the economy of both countries. For example, in a partnership between Eurasian National University and a U.S. institution, students might have the opportunity to pursue a program where they earn a degree from both institutions. Graduates of double diploma programs often have degrees recognized in both countries, enhancing their mobility and employability on a global scale.
