Our university was established in 1950 and it is the leading medical university in Kazakhstan for the training of qualified personnel for the health care system; it has a high reputation in the provision of educational, scientific, medical and diagnostic services.

Currently, the university implements multilevel training of specialists: bachelor' degree program, postgraduate (master's, residency, doctoral studies) and additional education. Training is carried out in the state, Russian and English languages. There are more than eight thousand students at the university. Our graduates successfully work in Kazakhstan, countries of near and far abroad.

Karaganda Medical University is the first medical university of the Republic of Kazakhstan that successfully passed the certification of the quality management system of the university of educational, scientific and clinical activities for compliance with the requirements of the International Standard ISO 9001 by the certification body NQA - UK (Great Britain), NQA - Russia in 2005-year. In 2015 it was certified by SGS (Switzerland), in 2020 the university was recertified by the Certification Association "Russian Register" (Russia).
