Institutional Description (limit 250 words): The Kazakh-American Free University (KAFU) is a fully licensed and accredited private university established in 1994 as the first private university in Kazakhstan operating through a partnership with the United States. Over three decades, KAFU has evolved from a single classroom in 1994 into a well-reputed university of international partnership. University mission is to develop leaders of the 21st century for the benefit of Kazakhstan. The mission is pursued with an emphasis on international and cross-cultural cooperation as an important part of educational process. Guided by the core values of commitment, integrity, academic excellence, diversity, equity, and inclusion, the university strives to empower students to become agents of positive change in their communities and beyond.

The university offers 26 undergraduate, 10 Master's and 2 PhD programs. Languages of instruction are Kazakh, Russian, and English.

The quality of KAFU programs has been confirmed through various forms of accreditation, including national and international institutional and program accreditation - ACBSP (USA), ACQUIN (Germany). IQAA, (Kazakhstan).

KAFU extends its educational reach beyond traditional degree programs offering non-degree program for students, faculty, staff and international partners.

Research occupies a central role at KAFU, with each department spearheading investigations aligned with their respective program specialties. The university is accredited as a research institution.

KAFU has numerous active international partnerships with universities in the United States, Poland, Germany, Ukraine, and Russia. We also have active partnerships in the Turkic states, including Turkey and Uzbekistan.
