Institutional Description (limit 250 words):

Kazakh National Women's Pedagogical University was founded in 1944.

The university has had a long and complicated development experience and it has been contributing to the country's science and education. In 2008, Kazakh National Women's Pedagogical Institute was awarded the status of University by the Government's decree. In December 2018, the University was awarded the status of National University by the Decree of President of the Republic of Kazakhstan. There are 6 Faculties, Physics and Mathematics, Social and Humanitarian Sciences, Pedagogy and Psychology, Natural Sciences, Kazakh Philology, and World Languages and Arts and Culture and 28 Chairs. In the 2018-2019 academic year, 55 educational programs were successfully accredited by Independent Agency for Accreditation and Rating (IAAR) and other 10 programs are accredited by Accreditation, Certification and Quality Assurance Institute (ACQUIN, Germany). The university keeps leading positions in annual institutional rankings among teacher training universities held by Independent Kazakh Agency for Quality Assurance in Education (IQAA). Kazakh National Women's Teacher Training University conducts and develops international cooperation with several foreign partner universities. The main partners are Hubei University (China), Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University (Turkey) and others. These agreements regulate issues of academic mobility of students and faculty, guest lectures of leading researchers, the implementation of joint research, research internships for Master's and Doctoral students, etc. In addition, Doublediploma programa are being implemented with Mississippi Valley State University (USA) and Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University (Turkey) and with university of Sussex (UK).

In 2021, in addition to national rankings, the University strengthened its position in world rankings. Our University is focused on preparing teachers from all the rural regions. It is considered as the only one higher establishment that develops female leadership, personal development and impact on modern Kazakhstani society.
