Northwestern is a comprehensive research university that is deeply interdisciplinary across multiple schools and units. Its rigorous academic environment provides a mixture of theory and practice, with an emphasis on top-tier research, new knowledge, creative expression and practical application. Instruction is provided in over 200 academic concentrations across 12 schools and colleges, at campuses in Evanston and Chicago, Illinois, and Doha, Qatar.

In 2023, Northwestern joined an exclusive group of peers whose annual research funding is \$1 billion or more. True to its interdisciplinary culture, Northwestern's collaborative research spans a spectrum of areas including neuroscience, nanotechnology, biotechnology and drug discovery.

The University's current priorities include advancing the biosciences; leading in decarbonization, renewable energy and sustainability; fostering interdisciplinary innovation among social sciences and global studies; harnessing the power of data analytics and artificial intelligence; enhancing the creative and performing arts; and delivering an outstanding educational experience for all students.

In addition to world-class academics and research, Northwestern offers a robust student life with over 500 studentrun clubs and 19 competitive varsity athletic programs. International students, who make up 25% of the student body, enrich the academic experience of all by contributing to Northwestern's cultural diversity.

Northwestern is committed to becoming a national model for how a major research university engages with the city in which it resides. The University equally commits to building strong, transparent, and strategic partnerships that enhance the impact of the University and the local community through collaborative efforts in health and public safety, economic development, and education.
