Institutional Description (limit 250 words): Ualikhanov University (UU) is a fast-growing regional university in the north of Kazakhstan with 60 years of history in providing high quality teachers, engineers and agrarians to the Aqmola region. Since 2019 the Higher School of Medicine was established to educate nurses and doctors. Ualikhanov University has a great reputation in the country for educating teachers in Kazakh, English, Russian and German languages as well as teachers in Natural sciences. Our top 7 programs in Education, Engineering, Mining, Agronomy have been leading in the Atameken Ranking that assess the graduate employment rate. UU is open to the world class experience and partner with more than 60 universities in 10 countries of the world, while 400 international students study at UU from 16 countries, mostly coming from India and Pakistan. 20 international projects Erasmus + funded by the European Union successfully implemented at the university campus with more than hundred faculty and students trained and retrained in the European universities. With our U.S. university partner Penn State, we are collaborating in soil and water quality research, we also sustain our partnerships with Visiting professors from the U.S. from the University of Washington, Dr. Talant Mawkanuly to develop a linguistic joint center and from Drexel University, Dr. Beth Leonberg in Medicine. We hope our membership in the Kazakhstan-U.S. Consortium will bring more productive and strong collaboration nets in research and innovation.
