Institutional Description (limit 250 words): K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University is a multidisciplinary classical university that provides the western region of Kazakhstan with qualified specialists and has become the core of applied science in the region. The university's 10 faculties and 23 departments offer 79 undergraduate and 52 graduate degree programs in a range of disciplines, enrolling about 14000 students as of 2023-2024 academic year. In order to increase the reputation of the university in the academic environment, the university has been actively working for several years to join the QS world ranking. A striking result of our activity was the entry of our university into the international rating QS University Rankings: EECA in 2021, taking 351 positions among the best foreign universities. The University became a member of the Bologna Process and the Magna Carta of Universities; the Shanghai University Cooperation Organization (SCOU); the Association of Eurasian Universities (EURAS); the Association of Asian Universities; the Association of Caucasian Universities (KUNIB) and the Scientific and Educational Consortium of the Republic of Belarus and the Republic of Kazakhstan.
